UCPath Location Data Update for AB119 Process



AB119: State Assembly Bill 119 (AB119) signed into law in 2017, contains a legal requirement for public institutions to have available the physical location of a represented employee's "workstation."

ROLES FOR LOCATION DATA PROCESSING

DEPARTMENT (REQUIRED)

- Responsible for submitting location on new positions or any updates to employee workstation location to SSC
- Confirms location with SSC

SHARED SERVICE CENTER (REQUIRED)

- Confirms location wtih Dept.
- Translates location into new Location Code Format
- Submits data in UCPath

CAMPUS SUPPORT CENTER (REQUIRED)

- AB119 Project Management, Process & End User Support
- Mass location data uploads
 MCDath configuration table
- UCPath configuration table updates

UCPC/UCOP LABOR RELATIONS

- UCPC applies campus location data configuration changes in UCPath
- UCOP is the process owner
